CONSIGNMENT REQUIREMENTS & F.A.Q.

- 1. Horses may be geldings or open mares.
- All Consignors must guarantee their animals are SOUND. A sound horse is defined as one who has no lameness or illness, including, but not limited to: eyesight, breathing, does not crib, sound in all four feet, etc.
- 3. Consignments require an entry fee of \$50.00 per horse, which includes the catalog fee. The sale committee will review all consignment submittals for each animal before it will be accepted into the sale. The entry fee is non-refundable once the animal(s) is accepted into the sale. Entries will be accepted past the catalog deadline, however there is no guarantee the animal(s) will be included in any advertising.
- 4. The catalog deadline is May 20th, 2017. Catalogs will be available around the end of May. Wild West Auctions will advertise extensively. We encourage you to submit your consignments as soon as possible to be included in any advertising outside of the catalog. The catalog will also include a map of the property for your reference. It is also recommend that you review and understand the buyer terms when you receive your catalog.
- 5. Photo Submission Guidelines: Please submit 2-3 good quality pictures of your horse(s) via email to wildwestauctions@me.com. If you are unable to email pictures, please mail with your agreement. Be sure the print quality is very good. If you need help taking or submitting photos, please contact us as soon as possible. Please also see our website for additional photo tips.
- 6. Video Submission Guidelines: We welcome you to submit video that showcases the abilities of your horse. A link to a 3-5 minute YouTube video should be submitted as soon as possible, so potential buyers can view it. If you need help taking or submitting video, please contact us as soon as possible.
- 7. Preview/Sale: Check-in will begin at 7 a.m. on the day of the sale. All animals must be checked in by 11 a.m. and all paper work completed. The horse preview will be held in the outside arena, weather permitting, starting at 11:00 a.m. Sellers are strongly encouraged to show their horse's skills in the preview, and in the sale ring. The sale will be held in the inside arena promptly at 1:00 p.m., rain or shine. Each horse will remain in the ring until bidding has stopped for that horse.
- 8. Sell, Sell, Sell: We want the sale of your animal to see the bids it deserves. We cannot stress enough the importance of providing us with as much information, photos and video about your animals as possible, as early as possible. We also encourage you to come early on the day of sale to allow your potential buyers to ask you any questions they may have. Be sure to practice with your horse frequently leading up to the sale. Ensure a brushed and clean coat is worn on the day of sale. Hip stickers will be provided to mark the lot number for your animal upon check in.


CONSIGNMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS


- Wild West Auctions & their associates act as agents only and are not responsible for buyer/seller error or misunderstanding. All guarantees are strictly between the buyer and seller.
- 2. All horses consigned to the sale must go through the ring. No substitutions will be allowed. Any additional horses will require a separate completed consignment agreement form and fee.
- All horses entering the ring will be sold to the highest bidder, the auctioneer has complete charge of the sale in case of a dispute in the bidding, and the auctioneer's decision will be final.
- 4. All consignors are responsible to read the cataloged information on their horse. If any information is incorrect, the consignor is responsible to announce any necessary corrections at sale time.
- 5. The commission will be 8% of the selling price, or the minimum of \$40; whichever is greater. Consignor has the privilege to no sale or pass out his horse. If the horse is never offered, the cost will be the entry fee, plus the \$50 never offered fee. If the horse is injured or sick, a veterinary certificate must be provided to waive the pass out fee. These fees are non-refundable.
- 6. Consignor checks will be processed as soon as possible, but within 5-7 business days after the sale to ensure all paper work is secured & buyer checks and credit card charges have cleared the financial institution.
- 7. All horses MUST have a current health certificate, negative Coggins test, and brand inspection (Proof of Ownership). Consignors are responsible for declaring HYPP status of Impressive bred horses, if applicable. Copies of registration papers and signed transfers will be required to be submitted to Wild West Auctions no later than the Monday before the sale. The originals must be present upon check-in day of sale.

This is a contract. By submitting papers to Wild West Auctions, you have consigned your horse(s) to the 4th Annual Wild West Auctions Horse Sale. Please remit one signed consignment agreement per animal, a signed arena release form, photos and video, copies of veterinary and registration papers, and the \$50 entry fee to Wild West Auctions, PO Box 3728, Alpine, WY 83128.

Forms can be emailed or faxed and Wild West Auctions does accept checks or money orders payable to Wild West Auctions or credit cards. A credit/debit card authorization form is included below and a processing fee of 3% (\$1.50) will be added to amount due for each animal consigned.
